Victoria is providing \$10 million to triple the size of an internship program where graduate students will work with B.C. businesses to help increase the province's competitiveness. Advanced Education Minister Murray Coell said the funds will help provide more than 650 **internships** over the next four years. The business community kicked in another \$5 million. The program is part of a national research network that brings together university researchers and companies in a collaborative effort to solve industry challenges.
